RE: Early detection PSP algae bloom – Mansons Landing, Cortes Island.

Dear Klahoose, fellow Islanders and recreational shellfish harvesters,

The Klahoose First Nation Fisheries WATCH program has detected early signs of **PSP algae bloom in the water testing (NOT TISSUE TESTING) area of Mansons Landing, Cortes Island**, We strongly recommend that shellfish harvesting in this area be avoided at this time – updates will be posted as they come!
