

Resort Maintenance

Reporting to the Resort Manager, the Resort Maintenance Person will be responsible for maintaining the potable water, septic, hydroelectric, and power generation systems at Klahoose Wilderness Resort. The Klahoose Wilderness Resort Maintenance person is also responsible for grounds-keeping, building, dock and trail maintenance, and garbage and recycling. The applicant must be proficient in operating small motor vessels. Crewboat operator experience is preferred. The Resort Maintenance person supports the rest of the Resort team as needed. This may include kitchen or housekeeping assistance.

KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- The Resort Maintenance position requires basic plumbing, electrical, carpentry, and mechanical skills. Maintenance includes the scheduled oil changes and service of 2 diesel generators and UTV.
- Efficient time management skills to meet demands while ensuring a healthy balance of work and down time.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Small Water Systems Operator certification is an asset.
- Basic working knowledge of vessel safety with SVOP Marine Emergency and Restricted Radio Operator certifications are an asset.
- Knowledge of governmental safety and sanitation regulations
- Basic working knowledge of the safe use of hand and power tools including chainsaws are required. Chainsaw operator certification is an asset.
- Effective decision making and critical thinking skills.
- Self-motivated with a cheerful outlook and a consistent display of professionalism.
- Klahoose Wilderness Resort showcases the culture of Coast Salish First Nations. Indigenous heritage and a knowledge (or a willingness to learn) the history and culture of Coast Salish peoples is an asset.





WORKING CONDITIONS:

- The job requires the incumbent to safely lift items weighing up to 50lbs.
- The job requires the incumbent to live at Klahoose Wilderness Lodge during work shifts.
- The applicant should be in good physical condition. Klahoose Wilderness Resort infrastructure is located on steep terrain and the maintenance person is required to access all these areas for maintenance.
- Exposure to varying temperatures both indoors and outdoors.
